BACKGROUND

Hepatitis B surface antigen (HBsAg) is the envelope protein of HBV and the principal serological marker of HBV infection. HBsAg appears in the blood weeks before symptom onset and persists in chronic carriers. Anti-HBsAg antibodies are central to HBV diagnostics, vaccine response monitoring, and IHC for liver biopsy assessment.
